

#### **CHUMREAP SUOR**

Cambodians traditionally greet with a Sampeah, which involves pressing the palms together before and center of the chest with a slight bow and greeting with a polite 'Chumreap Suor'. Customarily, the higher the hands are held and the lower the bow, the more respect is conveyed.

Except when meeting elderly people or government officials, between people, this custom has been partially replaced by the handshake. Women usually greet both men and women with the same traditional greeting. Although it may be considered acceptable for foreigners to shake hands with a Cambodian, it is more appropriate to respect the custom and respond with a 'Chumreap Suor'.

### **CUSTOMS AND TRADITION**

Cambodian culture and tradition have had a rich varied history dating back many centuries. Over the years, the people of Cambodia developed a set of unique tradition from the syncretism of indigenous Buddhism and Hinduism.

Cambodians have been raised to respect their culture and are very traditional in their way of life.

Tourists will see the well mannered Cambodian expressing a friendly "Chumreap Suor" when they meet one.



## **ABOUT CAMBODIA**

#### LOCATION

There are mountains to the North and East but the land is mostly flat perfect for rice cultivation. Indeed, Cambodian Jasmine Rice had won the World's Best Rice competition three times in a row.

The green rice fields and trees are fed by the giant Tonle Sap Lake and famous Mekong River the 12<sup>th</sup> longest river in the world that flows through the country and the capital city, Phnom Penh. Minerals, oil and natural gas deposits were recently found beneath Cambodia's territorial waters valuable assets that will surely contribute to this burgeoning economy.

#### **CLIMATE**

Cambodia's climate is hot and sunny all year round. Like most Southeast Asian countries there are two seasons the rainy season and the dry season. The rains fall May-October and it is dry during November April. December and January are the coolest months and April is the hottest. The average temperature is 27-28°C. During the rainy seasondownpours are limited to a couple of hours a day in the late afternoon or overnight so many tourists still come during this time to enjoy the country.

#### **POPULATION**

Cambodia's total population is roughly 16.72 million people, 95.6% of which belong to the Khmer ethnic group. Many foreigners live here too and some ethnic groups have made their home in Cambodia for centuries including the Chams (Muslim Khmer), Chinese, Indian, Vietnamese, Thai, Kuoy, Stieng and Tamil. Chinese people have a strong influence particularly in the business sector. Khmer is the official language of Cambodia.

#### **LANGUAGE**

Khmer is the official language of Cambodia. It is one of the oldest I anguages in the region and is derived from the Mon-Khmer (Austro-Asiatic) language family.

It is notable for its extensive alphabet with 33 consonants, 23 vowels and 12 independent vowels. Unlike other Asian languages, Khmer is not tonal and so is quite approachable for foreigners. While learning simple phrases is appreciated, English, French and Mandarin are widely spoken.

#### **RELIGION**

Theravada Buddhism is the oldest surviving form of the religion and is practiced by 90% of the Cambodian population. Cambodian Buddhism shares much with other Theravada countries but has many notable and unique qualities. Bud dha statues are revered in Cambodia and visitors are kindly asked to respect the customs surrounding these items (such as not pointing your feet towards a Buddha statue and dressing respectfully in temples). Islam, Christianity and Hinduism exist harmoniously alongside the main religion.



#### **NATIONAL FLAG**

The Cambodian national flag was adopted in its current in 1948 when Cambodia broke with the French protectorate. It was readopted in 1993 following the end of the civil war. The Angkor Wat temple represents the Buddhist religion of the country along with the dignity and heritage of the Khmer people. The blue stripes represent the king and also stand for liberty and co-operation. The red represents the people and also stands for bravery. In short, the flag sums up the slogan: "nation, religion, king."

## **VISITING CAMBODIA**



Cambodia can be accessed through three international airports (Phnom Penh, Siem Reap and Sihanouk International Airport) and two international sea ports (Sihanoukville and the Phnom Penh Autonomous Port). Tourists can also enjoy traveling to Cambodia by land and water from neighboring Laos, Thailand or Vietnam. Applying for a Cambodian visa is a simple process which can be done at all international points of entry into the country.

All nationalities, except for visitors from the ASEAN countries, are required to apply for a visa. Visa on arrival, which is valid for a 30-day stay is available at the above mentioned international airports, sea ports and border checkpoints.

However, not all nationalities will be granted a Visa on Arrival. It is better to apply at the Royal Cambodian Embassy or Consulate abroad before visiting.

A visa application form is usually issued on the airplane or one can be had on arrival. You will need one passport photo to accompany your visa application.

A 30-day single entry E-visa, can be applied by visiting www.mfaic.gov.kh complete an online application form, upload a recent passport sized photograph in jpeg format. Allow at least three business days for processing.

Note that an E-visa is only valid for arrival at Phnom Penh or Siem Reap international airports, Cham Yeam (Koh Kong), Poi Pet (Banteay Meanchey) and Bavet (Svay Rieng).

#### **BY WATER**

Cambodia can be reached by boat from neighboring countries and the world. The Preah Sihanouk International Seaport, the Phnom Penh International Port and Kompot international Tourism Port are three main gateways to Cambodia.

The Sihanouk International Seaport receives international cruise ships that accommodate hundreds of visitors.

It is possible to reach Phnom Penh Capital by ship along the Mekong River from Vietnam. Phnom Penh is connected by fast local boats to the Upper Mekong River close to Laos or it is linked along the Tonle Sap to Siem Reap Angkor.

By this means, visitors can enjoy the Mekong's view and discover the new growth area of Cambodia full of natural resources, cultural heritage, and life styles of the Cambodian people.









## SIHANOUK INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Sihanouk International airport, located 18 km north of the town, has been experiencing a robust traffic growth since its re-commissioning in 2007 thanks to the launch of international routes and the opening of several new lines serving this destination.

In 2019 the arrival was up to 1.6 traveler and is served by 10 airlines covering 11 destinations. Now with the completion of renovation of the existing building and the extension of the current terminal by 80%, from 2,700 sqm to 4,800 sqm.

In 2020, the airport achieved ACA carbon reduction certification level 2. This new level of certification is a recognition of the relevance of the VINCI Airports' global environmental policy which establishes goals for its airports based on its commitment to the preservation of the environment. It also recognizes the airports' actions to manage and reduce CO2 emissions and rewards a multi-annual effort to control and reduce their carbon footprint.

In 2021, Samdech Akka Moha Sena Padei Techo HUN SEN had inaugurated new infrastructure for preah sihanouk province. Another key strategy development for Cambodia's coast.



## DUTY FREE

Besides the Duty Free Shop in the airport there is also CDF (Cambodia Duty Free) located in Samdech Tehno Park and Naga City Walk (underground) explore the first underground retail gallery. In partnership with China Duty Free Group, they offer over 200 luxury brands from all over the world and authentic souvenirs from Cambodia - Kingdom of Wonder. A full assortment of genuine luxury products including perfumes, cosmetics fashionwear, handbags, luggage, accessories, jeweleries, sunglasses, watches, liquor, tobacco, travel accessories and confectioneries with the best duty free prices in Asia are available in the stores.



#### **ELECTRICITY**

Voltage: 230 V Frequency: 50 Hz Pictures - Power sockets

The standard voltage in Cambodia is 230 V and the standard frequency is 50 Hz. See pictures for the types of power sockets and corresponding plugs.

#### **VISA ON ARRIVAL**

Visa on arrival is available for selected country and the counters are located with in the arrival halls of all international cheek points You will need to check on the application requirements from your nearest Royal Embassy of Cambodia for the specific visa on arrival requirement.



#### **MONEY EXCHANGE**

Cambodian riel (KHR) is the official currency. However, the US dollars are in common use. Most businesses in the country, especially hotels, restaurants, airlines, markets and souvenir shops actually set their prices in US dollars. Change of less than one dollar is given in riel. Do inspect the bills when accepting money. Marred riel is acceptable tender, but the tiniest tear in a large US note renders it unusable in Cambodia.







# PREAH SIHANOUK PROVINCE


The numerous splendid beaches by the seaside town of Sihanoukville range from relaxing and peaceful to lively and vibrant.

Regardless of which beach you visit, you will be met with breathtaking views of the gulf, endless outdoor activities, and some of the best seafood in the region.

Enjoy the tranquility as you watch the sunset on the pristine white sands while sipping refreshing coconut water is certainly a luxury you deserve.

For the bolder beachgoers, there are ample outdoor activities like windsurfing, Kitesufting, sailing, snorkeling, boating, fishing, island-hopping, and scuba diving.

Scuba and Sailing certifications are also available at some of Sihanoukville's PADI Dive Centers and sailing clubs. The offshore islands of Koh Rong and Koh Rong Samloem are prime sites for a day trip or long-stay vacations of staycation with seclusion







Occupying an area of 125 hectare, the Sihanoukville Autonomous Port (PAS) is the only international and commercial deep seaport of the Kingdom of Cambodia. Since 1960 Sihanoukville Port has grown to become the largest port in Cambodia The port is continually undergoing expansion and improvement and is now one of the main entry points for tourists to Preah Sihanouk Province. Many foreign warships also berth here for 'Rest and Recreation'. The beaches in Cambodia offer investment opportunities to foreign and private investors.







## **INDEPENDENCE BEACH**

Independence beach is the quieter, and more relax near to town beach. The beach draws its name from the historic Independence Hotel that sits atop that headland at the northeast called "otel pram-pul chann" (7-storeys hotel) by the locals and one of the remaining hotels since the colonial period. The beach stretching over a kilometre long and offers BBQ huts, restaurants and bars together on the clean white sandy beach. It's nice for family beach to escape from the crowds of ochheuteal beach.



## **SOKHA** BEACH

Home to Sohka Beach Resort and its renowned hospitality signature, this 1.5-kilometre-long beach is one of the most delightful beaches in Sihanoukville. Situated between the Independence and Serendipity beaches, the resort area can be accessed and enjoyed by resort guests while the eastern end of the beach is available for the general public.









## **OCHHEUTEAL BEACH**

Ochheuteal's central location and cushy atmosphere make it the most popular beach in Sihanoukville. Rugged travellers would not mind temporarily residing in a budget-friendly straw bungalow and eating in seaside shacks. Those preferring aircon accommodation can opt to stay in one of the upscalehotelsalongthebeach.

Ochheuteal is bordered by Serendipity Beach on the northern end.










## **OTRES BEACH**

There are dozens of untouched islands off the coast of Preah Sihanouk. Koh Rong and Koh Rong Samlon both feature blissful untrodden beaches with palm-shaded shorelines and offer lots of diving opportunities.



















## KOH RONG SANLOEM

Koh Rong Sanloem, located just off the coast of Sihanoukville and is sister island of Koh Rong. Is one the beat known island.

It is a beautiful relaxing island with pristine white sandy beaches and a tropical jungle for nature lovers to explore.

Koh Rong Samloem is 9 km long and 4 km wide, with hilly terrain and a low mountain range. Most of the island interior is covered in jungle forestry with

the coastline being characterized by sandstone rock formation.

The main beach is in Saracen Bay, a quite laid back atmosphere with a range of resorts and guesthouses also lines with plenty of restaurants and bars.

Activities such snorkeling, scuba diving, kayaking and jungle trekking can enjoy by the guest when you in the island for a daytrip or during your overnight stay.




## KOH SONG SAA

## **REAM** BEACH



## **KOH PUOS**

Koh Puos or Kaoh Puos , Snake Island named (Elbow Island) during the French colonial period) is a small island in the Gulf of Thailand, located about 0.63 km off the coast of Sihanoukville city in southern Cambodia. It is administered by Sangkat 3 of Mittakpheap District in Sihanoukville Province.

The island has been made accessible via a road bridge, completed in 2011 as part of a development initiative of the Russian Koh Puos Investment Group (KPIG). A long term government concession granted in 2006 was followed by large scale planning of "a high-end property project".








## **KOH TA KIEV**






## **KOH SES**

Koh Seh or Koh Ses ( also romanized as Kaoh Ses, its former French name Ile a L'eau) is a Cambodian island located in the Gulf of Thailand, inside Ream National Park, Sihanoukville province. It lies 1.5 km (1 mi) south of Koh Thmei and around 9 km (6 mi) south of the main land of Sihanoukville's Ream commune.

A 4.3 km (3 mi) wide sound separates it from Phu Quoc. "Koh Seh" means Horse Island. Less than 400 meters south west of Koh Seh lies the tiny islet of Koh Ky. Koh Seh is uninhabited while most of its shores are fringed with mangroves. The island constitutes the south-easternmost part of Ream National Park.



## KOH PRING

## **KOH THMEI**




















## KOH KONG PROVINCE

Koh Kong town, the capital of the province, is a relaxed riverside town, where visitors can stay and easily access boat trips, beaches and eco-tourism. Nearby, the Cardamom Mountain boasts one of the last old-growth rainforests in Southeast Asia, where visitors may participate in ecotourism initiatives such as hiking, waterfall visits and wildlife-watching. The Peam Krasop Mangrove forest is the largest in Southeast

Asia and there is also a beach reputed to be one of the best in Southeast Asia.

Koh Kong is situated right on the border with Thailand. Since the 1,900 metres long bridge, the longest in Cambodia, was built at the cost of \$7.2 million USD to connect Koh Kong and the Koh Kong Resort, the town has been a popular point for people to hop between the two countries.

















## **MANGROVE** FOREST

Cambodia has about 50,000 hectares of mangrove forests. In the Boeng Kayak area, there is an elevated walkway where guests may explore this unique habitat. This project provides work for the community in the surrounding villages.

The mangrove forests house many endangered species and hundreds more. The 23,000-hectare Peam Krasop reservation is home to saltwater crocodiles and protects the breeding grounds for shrimps, crabs and shellfish. The forest also serves as a stopover for migrating birds like the Asiatic Dowitcher and the rare Spotted Greenshank. Boats are available for hire to provide the best views of the wildlife.

Visitors can also see snub-nosed Irrawaddy dolphins that are under threat due to the destruction of their natural habitats. At night, accommodation is available at a resort where there is a restaurant and several bungalows beset by beautiful fireflies at night.





Approximately 60km from Khemarak Phoumin city, Koh Kong province and close enough to Thmar Bang downtown.

# KAMPOT PROVINCE



Bokor National Park is popular for its cool mountain climate and the misty clouds that surround its summit like the mystical orient of the old stories.





















There are about 1300 hectares of cultivation land of Durians in Kampot province, of which 940 hectares have been harvested. Total yield of durians in Kampot province is about 12,280 tones per year.










# KEP PROVINCE

Kep is a quiet seaside town. Every morning fresh crabs and squids are pulled out of the waters and barbequed by the beach making the most wonderful breakfast. Fresh fish are also cooked in various restaurants built out into the ocean so visitors can hear the water lapping the shore below. Kep beach has been revamped to make it great for swimming and the surrounding national park is perfect for hiking. There are several islands accessible by boat with Koh Thonsay "Rabbit Island" being a popular spot with some nice bungalows so visitors can stay overnight.









# **RABBIT ISLAND**


